

## Chinese Thinker Research Assignment

You will have 2 class periods to research the following information about your assigned Chinese Thinker (I suggest that you divide the questions up amongst group members to save time and ensure all are doing their part.):

1. Give some important information on their life. (What helped shape their belief?)
2. What are their main beliefs and practices?
3. Who followed the philosophy?
4. How did it influence Chinese Society?

Visual Aide - Create or print at least one visual aide that will help you to explain or show the above information. Some examples may be a map, chart, picture, any primary source or document, etc... You will have one class period to complete this.

Presentation - Your group will present your researched information using your visual aide. Every member of the group must have a part.

Grading - During the second day of research, I will take a grade for your research (10 points). During the presentation I will grade your group using the attached rubric.

Make sure you are taking advantage of class time given to work on this project. Anything not completed in class will need to be done for homework. !
