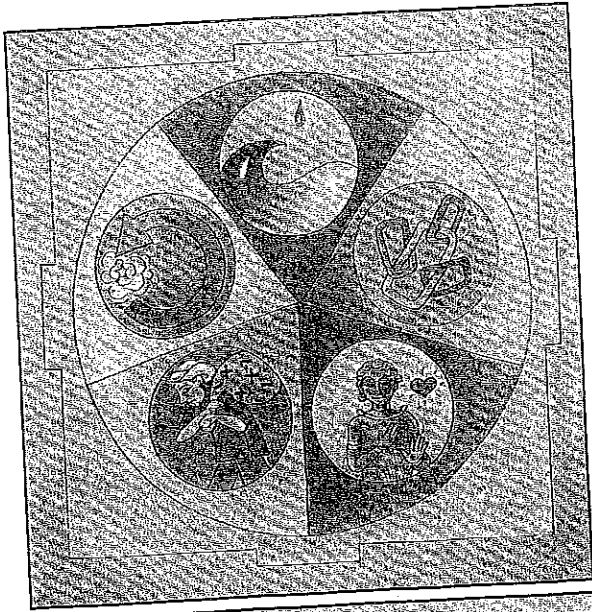


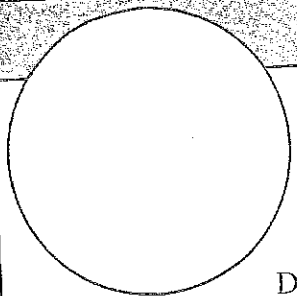


# READING NOTES 15

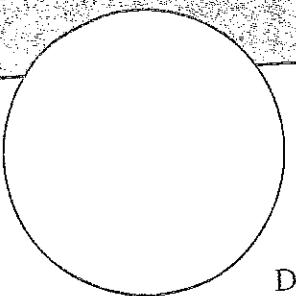
